



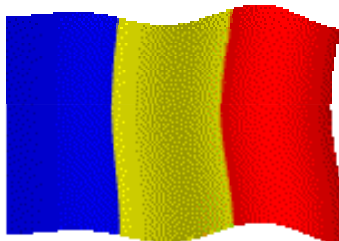

While home this past year, we learned how we could help meet a local need through our ministry. IHGM became involved through the Second Harvest Program of food distribution. Being part of this program enabled IHGM to help the Greenville County Foster Parents Association. Many children enter the Foster Program food deprived. By IHGM taking care of the essential needs of transportation and warehousing, Foster Parents are able to receive infant and toddler foods in case quantities for the children under their care. We distributed more than 10,000 cases to foster care families. We are grateful to God that IHGM can be part of such a helpful and needed program.
